#### **5. To Agree a Response to the request for a Scoping Opinion for Proposed Logistics Facility at Innocence Farm**

The Committee considered the scoping opinion request for a proposed logistics facility at Innocence Farm, land on the north east side of A14 Trimley St Martin east bound. The Committee noted that the request was for comments in relation to the scoping opinion only. SCDC had confirmed that no planning application has yet been submitted. The Committee identified a range of factors which they would expect to see included in the applicant's environmental assessment and asked the Clerk to record these in the response to Suffolk Coastal District Council.

The Committee also asked the Clerk to contact the clerks of Bucklesham, Kirton & Falkenham, Levington & Stratton Hall and Trimley St Mary to invite those Parish Councils to join Trimley St Martin in a request for a meeting to

discuss issues arising out of the Innocence Farm proposals with the Head of Planning Services and Richard Kerry, District Council cabinet member.
